

#### Validity:

This call is valid for the Thuringian Grill Battle on April 27, 2024.

#### Titles and awards:

During the Thuringian Grill 2024, each team will automatically take part in two evaluations with the submission of the dishes. Each dish is judged according to community rules. The points achieved in each case are included in two parallel independent evaluations. The two ratings have no influence on each other. Further explanations of the ratings are described below.

The team with the highest total score will receive the title:

## Thuringian Grill Master 2024

The team that prevails in the Thuringian Battle Master 2024 will receive the title.

# Thuringian Battle Master 2024

In the steak category, the participant with the highest individual rating receives the title:

#### **Thuringian Steak Champion 2024**

At the same time, the ratings are included in the national and international SCA rating (steakcookoffs.com), provided that the SCA Cook is registered.



These titles may be used by the grill team until the next competition for this title is held with the indication "acting" (the year can then be omitted) The results lists will be published as soon as possible after the award ceremony.

#### Starting classes:

The barbecue championship will be held without any restrictions on one class.

## Barbecue teams:

At the Thuringian Grill Battle, barbecue teams consisting of a maximum of eight active people can start.

Each team nominates its team leader. The communication between the organizers and the team only takes place through them.

To participate in the SCA category, each barbecue team can nominate a maximum of two individual participants.

# 1. Launch Permissions

All barbecue teams whose team leaders / individual participants (SCA) recognize the relevant rules are eligible to start.

If there is too much demand for starting places, the order of the registration date will be decisive.

Legal recourse is excluded.

# 2. Registration

Registrations must be **made by e-mail to** https://forms.office.com/e/3v4SBNW7NQ<u>or</u> service@grill-battle.de.

The following documents / files must be enclosed with the application:

- Team Name
- Name and address Team Lead
- Team logo incl. confirmation that the logo may be used in connection with the team for the event.
- Proof of existing private or commercial liability insurance
- Previous achievements (optional)
- Team slogan (optional)
- Names of max two SCA individual participants

Registrations received by other means will not be considered.

You will receive a confirmation of registration, which is accompanied by an invoice.



3. Entry fee and deposit

Teams whose payment is not received on time may lose their starting place. One Cancellation within the payment period of 14 days is possible. In case of cancellations after the payment deadline, only the deposit will be refunded. The barbecue team must provide the organizer with the bank details.

#### 4. Results, Certificates, Prizes

The certificates and prizes will be handed over on stage, the result lists and evaluations will be handed over after the award ceremony. In addition, the lists are sent to the team principals in a timely manner.

#### 5. Scoring, scoring rounds and submission times

#### a. Set of regulations

It will be evaluated according to the current community / SCA rulebook.

#### b. Rules and Regulations - Fire and Fun

The teams will be given evaluation sheets. These are to be filled out by the audience and thrown into a box at the stage. In order to maintain fairness, teams that rate themselves or other teams will be disqualified.



Scoring will be based on the highest average rating, and if there is a tie, the team with the higher number of ratings will be prioritized. If there is a tie, the decision will be made by drawing lots.

Each team has <u>100</u> evaluation sheets at their disposal, of which at least <u>25</u> must be handed in to receive a valid score.



# c. Scoring rounds and submission times (provisional indication)

The teams will be divided into four groups by the organizer ("Group A", ....." Group D"). It is decided by lot. The teams are informed at the team meeting which group they belong to

If the submission is delayed due to reasons of force majeure or organizational reasons of the organizer, the Jury Lead may extend the submission window.

The final determination of the submission times will take place at the team principal meeting.


**Evaluation Thuringian Grill Master 2024** 



Each team is evaluated independently. The judges will grade five criteria according to the Community Rules.

The judging is carried out by a blind jury.

#### **Evaluation Thuringian Battle Master 2023**



The evaluation of the preliminary rounds will be carried out by a blind jury. Semi-finals and finals will take place live on stage.

#### 6. Number of servings

Each team prepares 5 servings per course.

- 4 portions in food containers for the blind jurors
- 1 display plate for the exhibition in the competition arena, this is not included in the ranking. The showmen, i.e. one per course, are to be brought by the team itself.



For the "**Thuringian Battle Master 2024**" **rating,** four teams of the semi-finals and the two teams of the final each prepare 5 more dishes per course. The food is served on plates provided for the table jury.

Food containers will be provided by the organizer.

All products except the mandatory components are to be procured by the teams, the organizer also provides a shopping cart with products.

#### 8. Grill and barbecue equipment

The grill and barbecue equipment must comply with the applicable regulations and must be brought by the grill team itself. Only barbecues for wood and charcoal are permitted. The grills will be checked before the start of the competition. The teams are responsible and liable for the barbecue equipment and the danger it poses.



#### 9. Competition check

Each Battle Team has a competition check in the size of 6m in width and 6m in depth. A team that competes exclusively in the SCA classifications receives an area of 3m width and 6m depth. In the case of elaborate set-ups, this must be agreed in advance with the organizing team, there is no entitlement to a larger competition check.

The competition diamond is to be closed by the team itself against visitors and unauthorized persons.

All actions, including promotions for the Fire and Fun competition, must take place within the competition square.

#### **10.** Presentation

The sale of goods is not permitted.

If a team performs music, the team must register this with GEMA on its own responsibility. For reasons of fairness, musical performances or the like should not interfere with the neighbouring stands.

#### 11. Control

Commissioners will be appointed by the organizer to check compliance with the rules and hygiene. Commissioners must be granted full access.

At the request of the Commissioner, the barbecue teams must show and open all warehouses such as refrigerators, crates, vehicles, etc. By registering and starting, the teams accept these controls. The commissioners do not make decisions that fall within the remit of the Jury Lead.

#### 12. Media

All teams and their members assign all rights to image, word and sound for publications in print and audiovisual media (radio, television and the Internet) to the Organizer. We ask all teams to register and accredit already confirmed media companions with the organizer. Winners who leave the stage after the award ceremony must make themselves available to journalists for interviews and photo shoots for a reasonable period of time.

#### 13. Safety

For fire safety reasons and fire safety regulations, each team must bring an approved and tested fire extinguisher (at least 3 kg) and a fire blanket. Each team has to bring a first aid kit. Gas barbecues are not permitted.



For emergency extinguishing, keep a bucket of water within reach. All tents and other things that can fly away due to storms must be secured. However, the organizer is not liable for damage or theft.

## 14. Hygiene

Attention must be paid to hygiene. In any case, smoking is not permitted in the competition check.

## 15. Team Sponsorship

Sponsorship of the team and refinancing by sponsors is generally permitted. However, the following advertising measures are subject to a fee:

- 3 Posters, flags, etc. up to DIN A0 are permitted.
- Presentation of products in competition check must be registered
- Live tasting and the sale of products is not permitted in the competition checks. The manufacturer in question is welcome to apply for a stand here. In general, further advertising measures must be discussed with the organizer and registered no later than four weeks before the competition. Advertising measures are to be paid in due time after invoicing.

Unregistered advertising will not be allowed and must be removed or covered.

#### 16. Nights

You have to provide your own accommodation. Addresses can be requested from the organizer.

#### 17. Event Grounds

The ground is a paved square.

Garbage, hot ashes, etc. are to be disposed of in the containers provided for the teams and exhibitors. There is also a container for residual waste that can be used by the teams. The rubbish bins set up in the event area are intended exclusively for visitors.

The floor covering must be protected from damage.

The pitch must be left in a clean condition after dismantling and will be inspected by a groundskeeper. The deposit will then be refunded at the information desk. In the case of stalls that have not been approved, there is no entitlement to a refund of the deposit. The liability of the barbecue team for damage to fixtures or the site remains unaffected.



#### 18. Assembly and dismantling

At the start of the event, no vehicles (including refrigerated trailers) may be on the competition grounds. Parking is available.

In the interest of visitors to the event, it is expressly undesirable to dismantle the stands before the end of the award ceremony on Saturday.

Vehicles will only be admitted after the award ceremony.

#### 19. Water

A water intake point with cold water will be provided. Each team is responsible for its own hand washing facilities.

In principle, a canister with a drain tap, a soap dispenser and disposable towels are sufficient. More details will be announced during the set-up or team meeting.

#### 20. Current

There are power distributors on site. The teams must bring their own multiple sockets and sufficient extension cables.

A connection of 230 V max. 2.5 kW is available per team.

In your own interest, the cables should be marked with the team name. The organizer is not liable for damage caused by incorrect connection of its own devices to energy sources.

#### 21. Wcs

Toilets are available in sufficient quantities.

#### 22. Timeline

A schedule will be sent to the registered teams in good time and will also be handed out in 2 copies at the team meeting.

The organizer reserves the right to unilaterally change the terms and conditions of participation and the tender guidelines, insofar as this is appropriate in the interests of the event. The teams that have already been registered will be informed of any changes.
